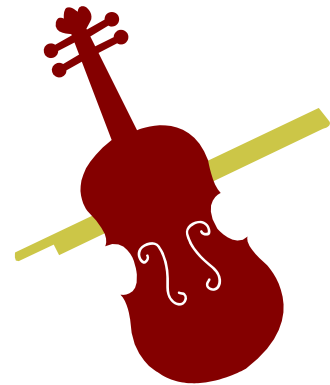
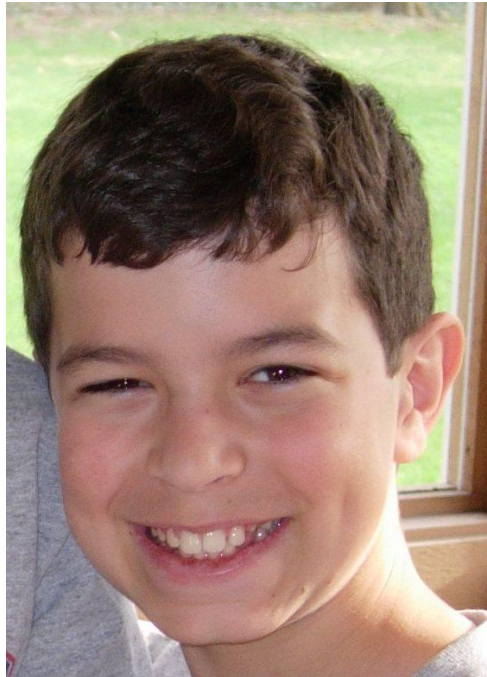


PETS WITHOUT PARENTS
