

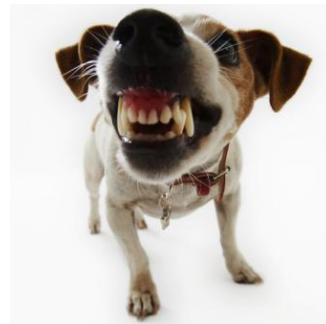
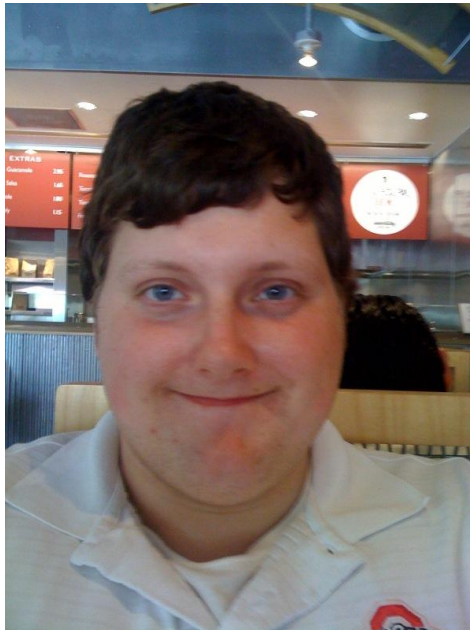


PETS WITHOUT PARENTS
